Allison Justiss Volunteer Scholarship

Scholarship Eligibility

The Allison Justiss Endowment provides a \$12,500 college scholarship each year to an outstanding Volunteer at Baptist Health's Little Rock based hospitals. The endowment is administered by Arkansas Community Foundation.

Allison's family, Rebecca and Al McDowell, Laura Justiss Zehr, and Alex and John Justiss, established the scholarship to perpetuate her memory as a Volunteer on the 9B Nursing Unit at Baptist Health Medical Center – Little Rock.

Allison volunteered at Baptist Health Medical Center – Little Rock through her participation in the American Heart Association Sweetheart Program. She volunteered over 300 hours in only three months and chose to spend her school holidays working on 9B.

By providing this scholarship, her family hopes to inspire other Volunteers to share in the joy Allison received in volunteering and being of service to others.

The scholarship may be used for valid school-related expenses to further the recipient's education at an accredited two- or four-year college, in Arkansas.

Scholarship Renewability

This scholarship is not renewable.

What you'll need to submit with your application:

- A high school transcript
- A letter of recommendation from a volunteer supervisor
- Certification of a minimum of 100 volunteer hours during fall semester of your senior year
- A statement addressing the financial need of the applicant
- A 250-word essay on the importance of youth volunteerism
